1. Superintendent/ Director Report

Jennifer Hernandez updated the Board with enrollment numbers from the Flint Campus, which are at 169 researchers, and the Washtenaw Campus with 43 researchers. Performance Testing has started at both Campus sites. FAFSA window opened on October 1, 2016. Attendance has been encouraged at both sites, and we are seeing an increase in student attainment. Reviewing two-way communication reports for the upcoming count. Trying to increase parent involvement by offering workshops for parents to attend within the building. Board shared they would like to see more parent involvement in the buildings. The board also shared that it's very important to ensure that we are providing our researchers a quality education.

2. Flint Campus Update

All AdvancEd documents have been completed and submitted. Fall Math & Reading Performance Series testing is complete and we met our 95% compliance goal. Excellent count day attendance was reported, and we had 96% attendance.

U of M Flint visited the researchers on Monday, September 19, 2016 to discuss the admissions process. U of M Flint representative (Ms. Benson) scheduled campus visits with some of our researchers.

We will have a guest speaker form the Flint Crisis Pregnancy Services Center in November.

The Academy has been selected by Keep America Beautiful to participate in phase two of the recycling program. Our Science expert, Kathryn Wood will be the Green Team Leader representing our school in the program.
